One Click Publishing Policy



As the One Click health advocacy pressure group has grown so enormously with many many thousands of Opinion Formers subscribed to our News Alerts from around the world with the material published on the website viewed by the residents of over 100 countries, so have the requests for the group to publish copy increased.

On average, One Click gets some 300 emails per day, a large number of which contain requests asking for us to publish the material contained therein. Whereas we very much welcome such great interaction with our readers, we are unable to fulfil all such requests. One Click is nobody's agent.

The vast majority of authors / information contributors take copy rejection on the chin as they must with all publishers, be they of the internet or terrestrial variety. But some unfortunately do not. To those few, we respectfully suggest that you move on.

One Click Copy Rules

The overarching remit of One Click is to cover patients and individuals in conflict with the State and powerful corporations. Please see the [One Click Bio](#) for the subjects that we cover.

One Click will not publish material if it is inaccurate, of insufficient quality, the proposition is vague, we suspect the dead hand of vested interests, we do not like the content, the subject matter is not an issue we cover or there is just not enough time.

One Click publication refusal equally applies to authors / information contributors, fortunately extremely few down these many years, who have failed to stand by their material in its entirety and/or who have not supported the publisher properly when legal action has been threatened.

It is the publisher that always carries the legal can in the first instance over information that is published. Although One Click is happy to take risks with the information that we publish as any good publisher should, we are not prepared to put the work of the pressure group in jeopardy for any individual or organisation that we deem unsuitable for whatever reason, particularly where it has been shown that support is not a two-way street.

One Click would like to take this opportunity to thank our regular authors / information contributors for the sterling work that they have done for years and to welcome new ones into the fold. We are so happy to have you around so that

we can publish your work and/or your information, either regularly or on occasion. You do the most wonderful job that benefits all.

We hope that by explaining the One Click publishing policy in public as set out above, a large part of potential author / information contributor disappointment will be avoided in the future. We very much welcome all copy contributions sent to One Click for review as ever, but we are never able to guarantee publication.
