Judge Riddle approved the Swedish request to extradite Julian Assange. The ruling will be appealed in the High Court within seven days. Assange's Swedish lawyer, Bjorn Hurtig, came out as the weakest link. Julian Assange's bail conditions remain extant.

The Appeal is likely to take many months. The European Arrest Warrant is 9/11 knee jerk reaction flawed law. This legal circus is set to run and run. The bills being run up by the Swedish taxpayer and Britain's legal infrastructure are substantial.
