## **BBC PANORAMA LOSES ITS VISION**

**Is it now a British Government mouthpiece protecting the vaccine industry?**

On 28<sup>th</sup> May 2009, I wrote an article about a BBC Panorama programme, '[A Very Dangerous Doctor](#)' that was aired on 1 June 2009 and referred to Dr David Southall. Expressing deep concerns about the bias I knew we could expect in this programme - and I was correct - I suggested in the section of my article headed 'Vaccine Programme Protection' that *"protection of the vaccine programme may lie behind why both Professor Roy Meadow and Dr David Southall brought their distortions in (re Munchausen Syndrome by Proxy and other adverse reaction deflections) to start with and why they are so well protected."*
