**PSYCHOLOGIST LISA BLAKEMORE BROWN  
TO SPEAK AT MODERN LIBERTY CONVENTION**



***Child's play? Equality and young people***

[Lisa Blakemore-Brown](#), Psychologist and Author, specialist in Autism and related disorders will speak on behalf of **Autism Rights** ([www.autismrights.org.uk](http://www.autismrights.org.uk)) and supported by **The One Click Group** ([www.theoneclickgroup.co.uk](http://www.theoneclickgroup.co.uk)) at The Convention, Modern Liberty in London on Saturday 28 February 2009.

Lisa's talk is part of "[Child's Play, Equality And Young People](#)", the only session on the day focusing on the rights of children and young people. Autism Rights is a Scottish based organisation but the issues they are concerned about, and which they lobby Parliament about, apply right across the UK. Lisa's talk will make reference to:

- The gradual creeping erosion and violation of the human rights of children with disabilities, particularly autism which has now reached epidemic proportions
- Autism as an impairment which is all too easy to dismiss as something else. The Government response has been to use various forms of legislation, Guidelines and training right across the board in Health, Education, Social Work and Law to severely hamper parents in their efforts to get diagnoses and forms of support and treatment for their children. In the worst case scenarios, and now widespread, the "diagnosis" of

Munchausen Syndrome by Proxy has been applied to multiple thousands of innocent parents and children and in some appalling cases children have been forcibly removed from their good homes with no way back. Despite Lisa's own efforts over 11 years to inform the Government about the Human Rights abuses and the suffering of children, no-one has listened and she herself was targeted. See [HERE](#). The Griffiths Inquiry team recommended the setting up of a working group to investigate the scientific validity of MSBP, but this was subverted into a committee that drew up government guidelines for distribution throughout the country. Every effort to make the Government look at its profound errors has been thwarted. See [The Consensus Report](#), Family Law Reform.

- Removal of children, denial of disability and blaming of innocent parents (some of whom are also disabled) using the label MSBP (Munchausen Syndrome by Proxy) later changed to FII (Fabricated and Induced Illness) is now so embedded in this paranoid system that "suspicion" of ANYONE by ANYONE replaces diagnosis by medics (who also made significant errors as the foundation theory is deeply flawed) to justify the above practices, in some cases leading to rapid forced adoptions. The system is in such crisis that young social workers are being enticed from abroad to engage in child protection, with no training which leaves even the young social workers traumatised. - A profoundly worrying [piece of legislation](#) about to become law in April will make a criminal out of any family or child who seeks media support to tell their story. The Government is using the Law to silence the media from exposing their mistakes and consequent Human Rights violations.
- The number of children with autism has skyrocketed over the last decade and there are suspected links to the vaccine programme. Professor Sir Roy Meadow, who thought up the MSBP "diagnosis" and was implicated in the shocking miscarriages of justice such as the [Sally Clark case](#) has been found only recently to have been a Member of the Joint Committee on Adverse Reactions to Vaccinations when autism and the use of MSBP began to rise and the vaccine programme was significantly altered. Government efforts to "keep a lid on it" have spectacularly failed. Indeed this very week the Government has finally admitted they have failed autistic children, in a pre-emptive strike against MP Cheryl Gillan's Autism Bill to be debated in Parliament on 27th February.
